



About Your Camera 50

- 1. Selfie Light: Adjustable light for better selfies.
- 2. Shutter Button: Captures photos or starts/stops video recording.
- 3. Power Button: Press and hold to turn the camera on/off.
- 4. Selfie Light Button: Controls the selfie light.
- 5. Type-C Port: For charging and data transfer.
- 6. Screen: Displays photos, videos, and menus.
- 7. Selfie Camera Lens: For front-facing photos and videos.
- 8. Memory Card Slot: Insert a memory card for extra storage.
- 9. Speaker: Outputs sound during playback.
- 10. Lanyard Attachment: For attaching a lanyard.
- 11. Main Camera Lens: For rear-facing photos and videos.
- 12. Gripper: Provides a secure hold.

Getting Started

Charging the Camera 50

1. Use the Type-C Cable:

- · Use a 5V/1A charging block with your Type-C cable.
- · Connect the Type-C cable to the charging port of your Camera 50.

2. Verify Charging:

- · Check the charging icon on the screen to ensure it is charging.
- When fully charged, the screen will display a fully charged status.

Powering On/Off the Camera 50

- · Power On: Press and hold the power button until the logo appears.
- · Power Off: Press and hold the power button again.

Setting Up Your Camera 50

1. Splash Screen:

Upon powering on, the Camera 50 displays the splash screen.

3. Wi-Fi Connection:

Enter the Wi-Fi password to connect your Camera 50 to the internet.


Scan the QR code on the screen using your smartphone to link your Camera 50 with the myFirst Circle app.

Using Your Camera 50

Basic Navigation





2. Select Language:

Choose your preferred language from the list and tap Continue.



4. Set Camera Name:

Use the on-screen keyboard to set a unique name for your Camera 50.



Power-On Default Mode:

Upon powering on, the Camera 50 immediately enters shooting mode.

Menu Access:

The menu provides direct access to core modules: Gallery, myDiary, Music, and myCircle.

■ Taking Photos



Photo Capture:

Press the shutter button to capture a photo.



Zoom Control:

Use the zoom button to toggle between 1x, 2x, and 3x zoom levels. For finer adjustments, press and hold the zoom control, then swipe to zoom.



Shutter Half-Press:

Half-pressing the shutter locks focus and exposure for more accurate shot

Recording Videos



Start Recording:

Long press the shutter button to start recording.

Stop Recording:

Press the shutter button again to stop recording.

Selfie Mode



Switch to Selfie Mode:

Tap the selfie icon to switch between the front and rear cameras.



Use Selfie Light:

Press the side button to activate the fill light. Press again to adjust brightness.

Gallery

1. Viewing Photos/Videos:





- · Tap the photo icon to browse and view photos and videos.
- View photos or videos in full-screen mode by tapping on the desired media.

2. Deleting Photos/Videos:





- · Select the media, then tap the trash icon to delete.
- Confirm deletion for single or multiple files using the "select" option.

3. Editing Photos/Videos:





Photo Editing:

- · Apply filters (Auto fix, Vibrancy, Brightness, etc.).
- · Use the crayon tool to draw, crop, or rotate the photo.



Video Editing:

· Trim video clips.

myDiary



1. Accessing Saved Al Videos: Open myDiary to view Al-generatedvideos that have been saved privately.



2. Saving to myDiary:

When creating or editing Al videos, select myDiary Privacy to save the content privately.

3. myDiary Pincode Management:



Access myDiary Settings:

Navigate to Settings > myDiary Settings.



Change Pincode:

Select Change Pincode. Enter your old pincode, then set and confirm a new one.



1. Template:



Tap the + icon to access templates.



Choose the number of photos/videos as required by the template.



Select a template from the Template Gallery.



After selecting your media, tap the Generate button, the video will be processed and displayed in a preview screen.

Add Enhancements (Optional):



Volceover Done

Countdown to start voiceover when user clicked Record button





After generating the video, you can add voiceover and stickers to enhance your creation.





Once the media is generated, save it to myDiary or share it with your Circle.

2. Al Video:



Tap the + icon and select Video to start creating an Al video.



Select Media: Tap to choose your media for

video generation.



Select Media with Voicenote: Press and hold on media to express your feelings about the event.



After selecting your media, tap the Generate button, the video will be processed and displayed in a preview screen.

Add Enhancements (Optional):





Countdown to start voiceover when user clicked Record button





After generating the video, you can add voiceover and stickers to enhance your creation.

2. Post:





Tap the + icon and select Post to create a post for myCircle.



Choose up to 3 photos or one video.



Add a description, then post to myCircle.

Music

Playing Songs:




Insert a memory card with stored music or transfer music files from your computer to the Camera 50.



Tap the Music icon to browse and play songs from the list. You can pause, shuffle, and repeat tracks.

Only MP3 format is supported. Upon restarting or inserting a new memory card, the Camera 50 will automatically generate a "Music' folder. Then you can copy the music files into "Music" folder.
